**Hello and welcome to the open-source, printable version of Deck of Disruptions! We're so glad you're here.**

Liminal has made this activity open source because we believe that when futures thinking is experienced as a lived practice, rather than only a professional method, its value becomes easier to recognize and sustain. Futures and foresight stops being abstract and becomes something practitioners embody.

This activity is not designed to be completed in a single sitting. Like any skill, it takes repetition and time. It often requires unlearning, especially for those most familiar in professionalized methods and organizational settings.

We ask that if you use this activity in a group setting (professional or otherwise) that you **please credit Liminal as the owner, author, and designer.**

We are hosting recurring community sessions every three to four months to create space for this practice to continue collectively.

**Gather Materials**

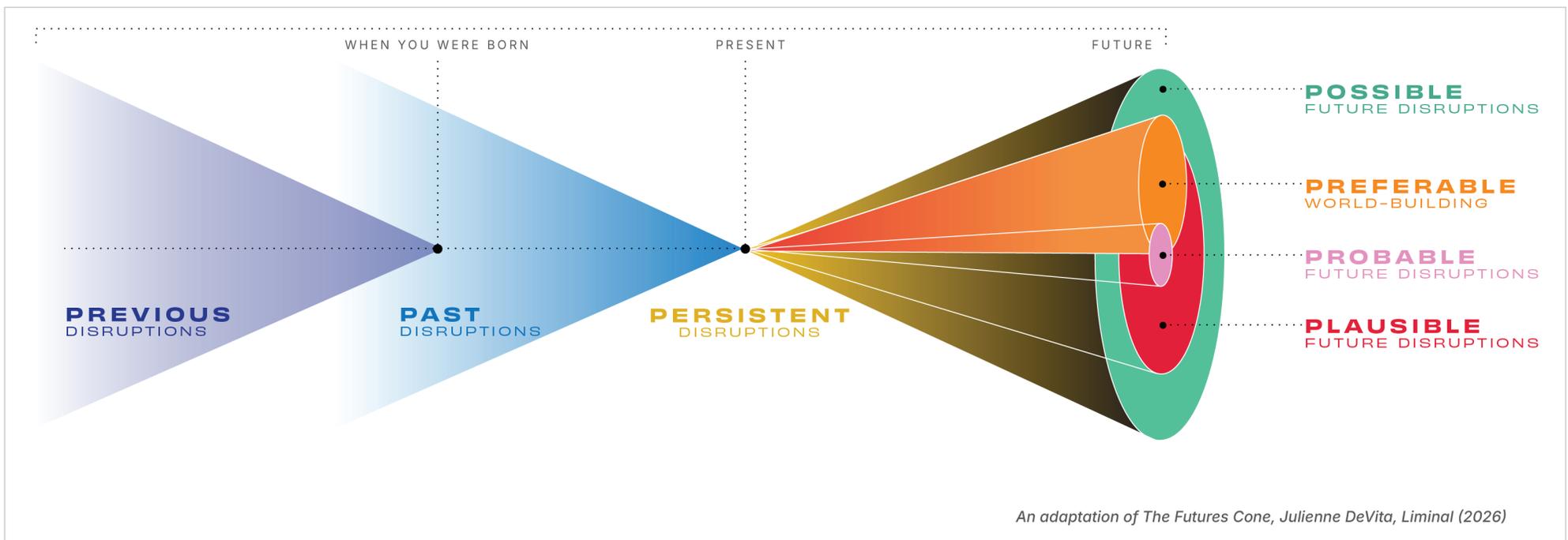
To build and play Deck of Disruptions, you'll need the following:

- A printed version of this document. Print double-sided, and cut the cards out.
- A pen or pencil.
- Scissors or a method to cut out cards individually using the crop marks on each page.
- A deck of small sticky notes (1"x2") to write disruptions on each card so that the deck can be reused. It is recommended to avoid writing directly on the cards, this way the deck is "alive" and can be modified down the road as your life inevitably changes.

Review the futures cone graphic on below, which has been modified by Liminal specifically for this activity. Familiarize yourself with the graphic as well as definition of disruptions.

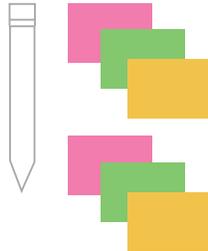

### Ideate Disruptions

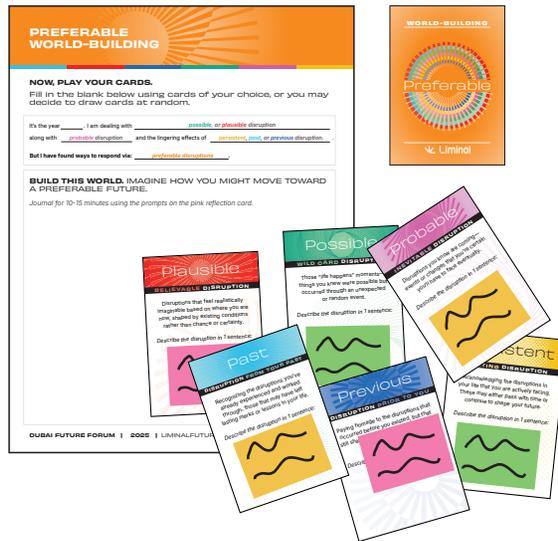
- Gather materials:
  - 1) Blank card deck (at least 3 cards per disruption are needed, 18 total)
  - 2) Worksheets: a) Disruption Worksheet, and b) Preferable Worldbuilding Worksheet
  - 3) Small sticky notes, about 20, sized at 1"x2"
  - 4) Pen or pencil
- Using the **worksheet** on the following page, write down the future time horizon you want to work within and how old you'll be in that year. We recommend using a 12-15 year time horizon, but the choice is up to you.
- In the boxes the worksheet, identify and write down as many possible disruptions you can think of, in the following order: 1) Probable, 2) Plausible, 3) Possible, 4) Present, 5) Past, 6) Previous. Set a timer for 5 minutes for each disruption.
- At the end of each round, select at least three of disruptions from each category, **write them down on sticky notes, and stick them on your disruption cards**. The disruptions you select should be the most interesting, provocative, or resonant to you. Do note: this printable version includes 8 cards per disruption, but to play the game you only need to fill out three cards per disruption. However, there is no limit, so complete as many sticky notes on cards as you like.

#### Tips:

- **Quantity is key.** Try to write constantly without overthinking your responses; don't move on to the next disruption category until the five minutes are complete.
- **You are encouraged to go deep and get vulnerable.** These answers are for you and no one else.
- **Remember, there are no "right" or "wrong" answers.**
- **We recommend using a 12-15 year future time horizon** for Probable, Plausible, and Possible disruption categories.

### Play Your Disruption Deck

- Gather materials:
  - 1) Card deck with disruptions written on sticky notes (at least 18 cards, 3 per disruption)
  - 2) Preferable Worldbuilding Worksheet,
  - 3) Pencil or Pen
  - 4) Preferable Disruptions card (orange)
- Locate your card deck. Shuffle the deck and randomly draw 1 disruption per category (6 total.) Place these face up on the table in front of you.
- Locate your Preferable card (orange) and Preferable Worldbuilding Worksheet. Using the fill-in-the-blank formula, create a mad-lib of your 12-15 year future time horizon. You can pick and choose from the six cards drawn at random.

  - 2) Pencil or Pen
  - 3) Reflection card (pink)
- Imagine and build this future world, journal for 10-15 minutes using the prompts on the pink reflection card, and also below:
  - *What do these disruptions mean for you, your family, and your community? Feel and imagine yourself in this world.*
  - *How do these disruptions reshape your life story? How might you need to pivot or adapt?*
  - *What possibilities open up because of these disruptions? What can you do now that you couldn't have imagined before?*
  - *How might you scale your actions toward preferable impact?*

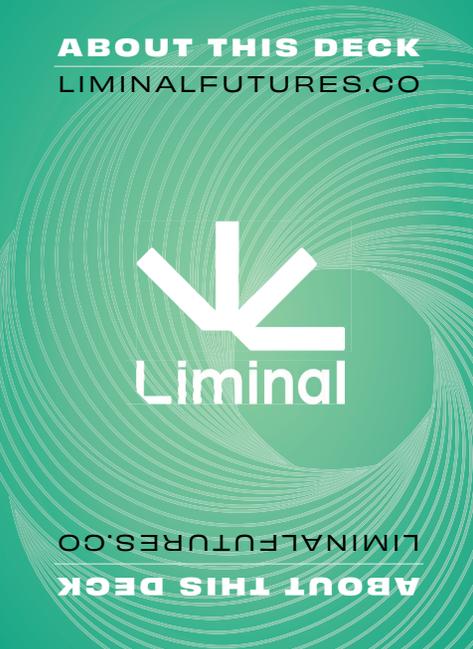

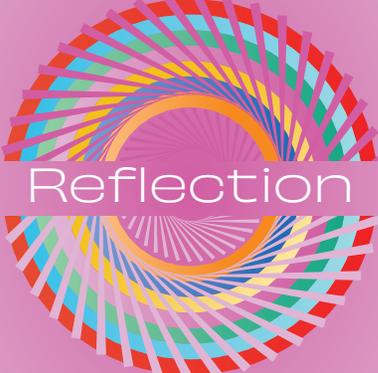

## ABOUT THIS DECK

This deck is created by **Liminal, a design futures agency** founded by Julienne DeVita. In collaboration with foresight practitioner Eric Popiel, the two prepared this activity for the 2025 Dubai Future Forum. This version is the second iteration of a larger open-source project that supports foresight practitioners in becoming better stewards of the field. The method was developed using an adapted version of the Futures Cone.

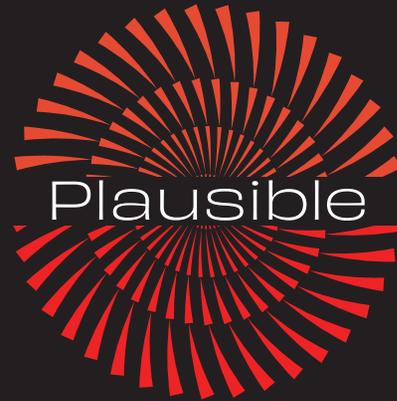

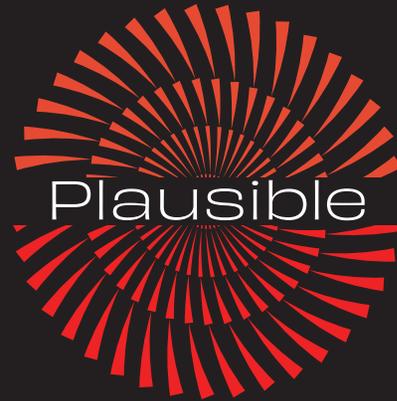
